The focus of the Council's work in August has been the 2018 church budget. We have undertaken a thorough review of each line item in consultation with all committee chairs, administrative workers, pastors, and Becky Arthur, who is

the Council Treasurer and Chair of the Finance Committee. Our goal has been to carefully assess our past expenses and income and to begin to prepare a budget that will frame our stewardship responsibilities in the future. This work will continue into September and October as we solicit additional input from the Finance Committee and as we gain a clearer picture of projected income as a result of our 2018 stewardship commitments submitted in September.

We have a special need this year for each of us seek God's direction for the ways in which we can share in the mission and fellowship of Grace Church.
