Church Council Report

This month I would like to share with you an important new activity that the Council is beginning called Mutual Ministry Review (MMR). The purpose of this process is to involve the Pastors, Council members, and the congregation in assessing together the work of the Church in relation to a set of explicit

goals, accomplishments, and challenges. MMR begins with the both the Pastors and the Council looking at the past year in terms of expectations and accomplishments. This analysis specifies what goals were satisfied, which were not met, what the difficulties were, and what might be done differently in the future. This step also results in developing a set of next-year goals from both the Pastors' perspectives and the Council's perspective.

Next, we combine this work into a mutual analysis of the past year and create shared goals for the coming year. The MMR process specifies ways to focus on specific outcomes and how the Pastors, Council, and congregational members will be involved. We plan to accomplish this joint work at a special Council workday on January 6. The results of this workday will be shared at the Annual Meeting on January 28 and then, based on congregational feedback, refined further at our Council retreat on February 3-4.

Catherine, Sharon, and the Council believe that this Mutual Ministry Review process will be an important step for Grace Church. It should add a new level of transparency about how the church leadership believes we are doing and provide specifics about where and how we want to proceed. It should also allow each of us to assess how we can become a part of achieving Grace's mission and goals. Please pay attention to this work in the next few months and look for active ways to participate!
